

## Configuring import from a text file

The “Customize import from a text file” dialog window can be opened by selecting a \*.TXT or \*.CSV text file. This dialog window is used for specifying the line the import should start from, the character that is used as a separator and the order of data elements in every line.

**Important!** To set these parameters, you must first get familiar with the contents of the file being imported. To do that, open it in any text editor, like the standard Windows Notepad.

The order of data elements in a line is defined in the following way:

1. Set a flag next to all the parameters you know are present in each line of the file
2. Select the elements one by one and move them using the Left and Right arrow keys to define the order of their appearance in each line
